# Library work to begin in July

Construction of a six-story addition to the existing library on the Texas A&M University campus is scheduled to begin in July 1977.

The annex will be built between the library and the Agriculture Building.

It is estimated that the construction will be completed in two and one half years, according to Paul Stephens, manager of planning division in the department of facilities. The annex will include a basement accessible to service vehicles for library deliveries.

Students will be inconvenienced during the construction because alternate routes will have to be chosen to avoid the construction site.

A crane system and trucks will arrive at the site by Lamar Street after

coming off of Jersey Street. The parking lot behind the Animal Science Building will be used for construction materials.

A fence will be installed completely around the site. The fence will extend to the edges of the construction and partly around the existing library. New sidewalks will be built along the fence to accommodate the students.

"The situation's not ideal for building purposes, but the other people have to be considered," Stephens said. "The construction site had to be cut down to size."

After the annex is completed, work will begin on the existing library. A different fence will be erected for the duration of the construction. This fence will enclose the entire area around the library. The fences will be changed to allow access to the new building.

The main entrance to the annex will be on the building's east side, in front of the Agriculture Building. This will be the only access to the building while work is underway.

The work to be done inside the library includes new carpeting and furniture.

## A&M students to go overseas

Modern language students at Texas A&M University will be taking advantage of overseas programs in France, Germany and Spain this summer.

Worth six hours of classroom credit, the projects provide the students a chance to live and study in the native country of the language they are studying.

The students, accompanied by faculty, will live with families in these countries while attending nearby universities. Weekend cul-

tural trips will augment the intensive language study.

This year, the French and Spanish trips are set for late June through early August, while the German program will be in late May through early July.

Academic headquarters for French students will be the Institut d'Etudes Francaises, located in La Rochelle. Spanish students will learn at the Universidad de Santiago de Compostela and German students at the Goethe Institute at Passau.

Unless you worked for the Agricultural Extension Service or the Forestry Service, you will receive one W-2 form from the University to be used in filing your income tax return.

W.B. Lancaster, assistant vice president for budgets, said that for fiscal purposes, all of the departments, except for the above, are listed under one section.

A student having any questions about information on his W-2 form should contact the department he worked for.

If the department is unable to help, the student can go to the payroll department for assistance.

The payroll department is in the basement of the YMCA building. Appointments can be made by calling 845-2026.

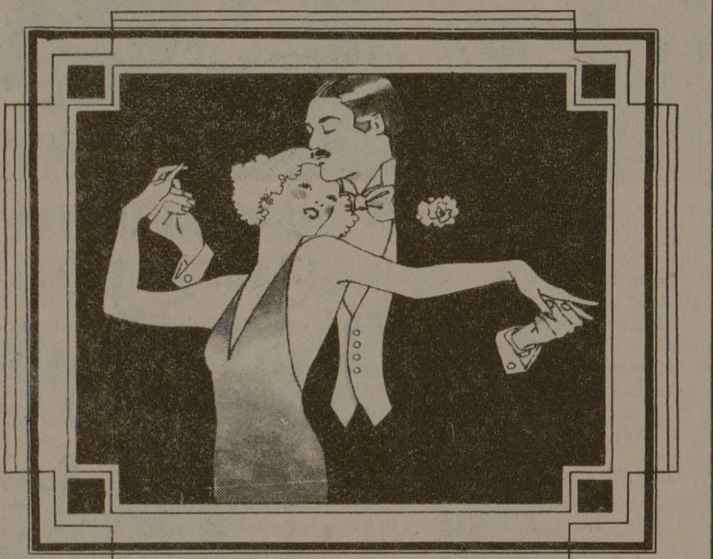
Since I'm a student, will I be able to get back all the money that was taken out of my checks for income tax purposes? — M.B.
