
Brazos County A&M club gets appointed officer

ATTORNEY GENERAL John Hill returned yesterday from Mexico with a list of crimes Mexican officials need help in investigating. At the top of the list is finding a Matamoros policeman who extorted \$14,000 from an American. COLLEGE COSTS will be pushed up eight per cent by in-flation, heating and salary costs by September — giving parents the biggest college bills in history. Authorities estimate \$100 of every bill is to cover the cost of complying with paper work required by the Federal government. State-supported schools on the average billed resident students \$1,797 for tuition, room and board last year; non-resident ones, \$2,680.
