Physicist explores nuclei

Dr. David Ernst is among a select group of scientists taking on new exploration of a primary building block of nature — the atom. The Texas A&M University physicist has the task of theoretically exploring the nucleus of atoms, using higher than normal energies, with a possible benefit being improved techniques for treatment of certain types of tumors. "This is the same kind of nuclear physics that has been done since the 1930s, but at higher energies," explained Ernst. "The ultimate goal is to understand how nuclei behave and through this understanding get a grasp on their ultimate properties."

"The neutron's location is generally known," Ernst said, "but not in the detail we would like." "This is just one of the studies that can be made by firing high energy particles (protons and pions) into the nucleus of an atom," Ernst continued. "The resulting products of the scattering and the new elements which are produced allow us to deduce the make-up of this nucleus."

He said the theory of operation of these elements and an accelerator in the search for neutrons can be explained in an analogy by substituting a flashlight for the accelerator, the flashlight's beam for the high energy particle, and the brain for a computer. "The light is turned on, the beam is reflected from an object and returned to the brain via the eyes," Ernst observed. "The brain interprets the information and tells you if the object is a chair or a table. In our case what the computer 'sees' is

Don't scratch, Health center reports outbreak of measles

Dr. Claude B. Goswick Jr., director of the University Health Center estimates between 50 and 75 cases have been reported since the week prior to spring break. Most of these were reported to notice a rash. Some students run a fever, but not often. There is an inoculation available but Goswick said the Health Center was not encouraging students to have it. He said the shot costs serious complications it really wasn't necessary. "We always have this every year or so," Goswick said about the increased number of cases. The health center is asking students who have the measles to avoid intimate contact with others in an effort to isolate the disease. Officials at the Brazos County Health Unit said there has not been an unusual number of cases reported.
