SENIOR RING ORDERING PROCEDURE OFFICE OF THE DEAN OF ADMISSIONS AND RECORDS

OFFICE OF THE DEAN OF
ADMISSIONS AND RECORDS

To be eligible to order the Texas A&M ring, an undergraduate student must have at least one year in residence, credit for at least ninety-two (92) semester hours and be in good standing with the University. A year in residence may consist of the Fall and Spring semesters or one of the above and a full summer session (both the first and second terms). The hours passed at the preliminary grade report period on March 23rd may be used in satisfying this ninety-two hour requirement. Students qualifying under this regulation should leave their names with the ring clerk, Room Seven, Richard Coke Building. This should be done prior to March 23rd in order for all records to be checked to determine ring eligibility. (Any student having completed ninety-two (92) hours at the end of the Fall '76 semester may order at any time. There is never a dead-line once the hours have been completed, with the exception of a monthly mailing date ) Graduate students are eligible to order with proof (receipt) that they have filed for graduation. Orders for mid-semester will be taken by the ring clerk starting March 23, 1977, and will continue until April 26, 1977. Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Please bring mid-semester grade reports along when ready to order. Anyone having falled to leave their names in advance and fail to bring grade report will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked. The rings should arrive at the Registar's Office on June 28, 1977. All rings ordered, regardless of whether on March 23rd or April 26th will arrive at the same time.

The ring elerk is on duty from 8 a.m. to 12 noon and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. of each week, Monday through Friday. However, in order for records to be checked, orders must be placed prior to 11:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. We hope this information will be helpful and extend our congratulations.

"For example, among our goals, we need to know how large the nucleus is and where the neutrons are located within it," he added. "These neutrons have no charge and as a result are very difficult to pinpoint," (A nucleus consists of neutrons and

The neutron's location is generally known," Ernst said, "but not in the detail we would like."

"This is just one of the studies that can be made by firing high energy particles (protons and pions) into the nucleus of an atom," Ernst continued. "The resulting products of the scattering and the new elements which are produced allow us to deduce the make-up of this nuc-

He said the theory of operation of these elements and an accelerator in the search for neutrons can be explained in an analogy by substitut-ing a flashlight for the accelerator, the flashlight's beam for the high energy particle, and the brain for a

The light is turned on, the beam is reflected from an object and returned to the brain via the eyes," Ernst observed. "The brain inter-

'Also, we are studying the teractions of these particles for a peculiarities which may be even ally applied to research elsewhe

Ernst said. For instance, besides aid physics, a proton in a high ener ccelerator can do a brain scan locate tumors as accurately as a other method, but with on thousandth the amount radiation he said. "Also, pions can be focus very well on tumors where they little damage to surrounding him and expand their energy in

tumor causing its destruction." Both of these particles have centricities which we will try to to learn new things about the ne leus," Ernst said. "Now we a mainly working on how you won use them (protons and pions) at his


