What do you consider to be your top priorities?

First I would reorganize refrigerator rentals, establish a working relationship with the Administration, and rebuild the Student Service Fees Allocation Hearings as they were a shambles this spring. In this reorganization I will welcome student input and more thorough working meetings on budget requests.

What are your feelings about service fees as opposed to user fees?

This fall and next spring there should be a definitive analysis of the amount of service fees vs. user fees utilized by each organization. I would like to see more user fees in those organizations which benefit fewer students.

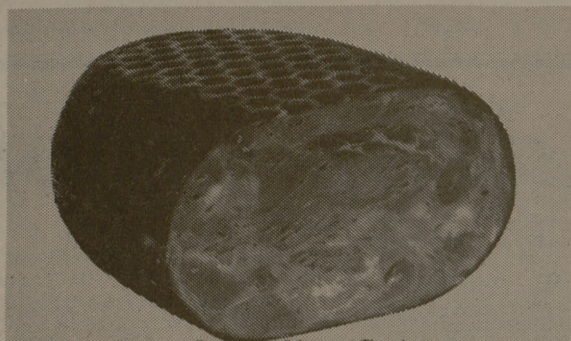

What are your feelings about service fees as opposed to user fees?

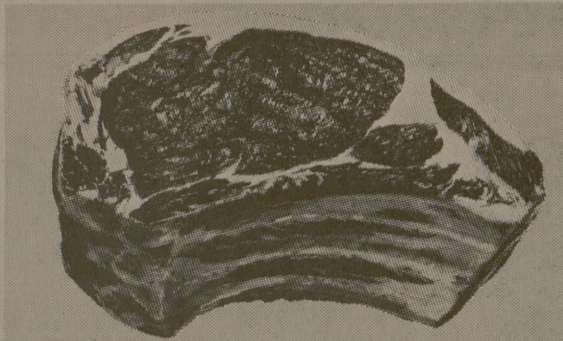
