### Sexual offenses go unreported

## Victims fear going to court, Luther says

There has been a lack of student response concerning two recent misdemeanor sexual offenses on the Texas A&M University campus, said Dr. John J. Koldus, vice president for student services.  
"The main problem is that unless these cases are reported, nothing can be done about them," Koldus said.  
After being arrested for indecent exposure in the Sterling C. Evans Library last month, a 19-year-old student confessed to numerous previous incidents that were never reported to Texas A&M University Police or the administration.  
The man admitted to incidents since January and said he had exposed himself at least 10 times on one day, University Police Chief O.L. Luther said.  
The victims did not report the incidents because they thought no action would be taken, Koldus said.  
"What they do not realize is that these people have a tendency to become progressively worse instead of getting better, and need to be apprehended," Koldus said.  
In this case, the library incidents were becoming more frequent, Luther said.  
Both the state and the University take action against these persons after they are apprehended, Luther said.  
If there is sufficient evidence, the case is taken to court, he said.  
The administration takes disciplinary action regardless, Luther added. A similar case took place two years ago.  
The offender was dismissed from the University staff but his case was never tried, Luther said.  
"The fear of going to court and embarrassment are two reasons we think these incidents are not reported," Luther said.  
"In order for the case to go to court we need substantiated evidence, if not a confession — a complaining witness," he said.  
"If the victims do not want to be

pre-hended, he confessed to two other offenses that had gone unreported.  
"He appeared to be getting more aggressive each time," said Luther. The man was dismissed from the University.  
There are four investigators at the University Police Department available to handle these cases, Luther said.  
"The cases are rare on this campus, but when they do occur we are investigating until they are solved," Luther said.

## Scientists find gold, silver while looking for fertilizer

WASHINGTON — Scientists have dug up a bonanza of precious metals, but it probably won't trigger any gold rush.  
Two scientists recently were looking for fertilizer in sewage from Menlo Park, Calif. Once they analyzed the burned ashes of the sludge, they turned up gold and silver worth as much as \$200 per metric ton, the U. S. Geological Survey said Wednesday.  
"This is greater than the value of much of the ore from the mines of

the Comstock in Virginia Nev., in its heyday," said geologist Robert Gulbrandsen. "If this were an ore body, it could be called a 'bonanza' ore," he said.  
Gulbrandsen said the high gold and silver content—as much as 10 parts per million for gold and 100 parts per million for silver—was associated with the industries in the area, particularly photography and electronics industries.
