Stengel was a tyrant. Keep after 'em he'd urge all his players. Don't let em up. When the Yankees were losing, though, when they couldn't do anything right, he was an entirely different person. Supportive, understanding and above all,

None of this was lost on Bill Martin during all the time he played for the old man, and now that the Yankees are having so much trouble, he's using the same soft Stengel technique, hoping it will help both him and the ball club.
