New assistant legal adviser to assume duties Monday

Eugene (Sonny) D. Lyles Jr., is the new assistant student legal adviser at Texas A&M University. The position was made available in February when Chris Kling was promoted to student legal adviser. The previous adviser left to open his own practice. Lyles graduated cum laude from Texas A&M in 1974 with a bachelor of science degree in political science. He received his law degree last December from Bates College of Law at the University of Houston. He has taken his bar examination and expects the results in mid-May, when he would officially be an attorney at law.

Texas weather data indicates last winter coldest since 1941

Was last winter the coldest for the state of Texas? Results are now coming in from the National Climatic Center in Ashville, N.C., where the state's winter weather data was compiled. The center's computers are trying to make some sense out of reports from 10 separate climatic divisions. Glen Lubens, who works at Texas A&M in the office of State Climatologist Dr. John Griffiths, showed evidence that this has been the coldest winter since at least 1941, beating even the winter of 1972-73 by .8 degrees of mean average temperature. The average mean temperature for this winter in Texas — the February and March figures aren't in yet — was a chilly 44 degrees. Last November's average of 45.3 degrees was tied in 1972, the December low of 45 degrees was beat by a 41.7 average in 1963, and January's icy 39.1 degrees was the state's coldest since 37 degrees in 1940.
