Sigma Delta Chi picks Raesner

Lorelei Raesner of Rosenberg was named Outstanding Journalism Graduate by the Society of Professional Journalists, Sigma Delta Chi. The "Heavyweight Award," which goes to a senior who has been an outstanding student and active in promoting better communications at Texas A&M, went to two of this year's graduates: Steven Reis of Bay City who worked for KAMU-TV (as host of "For Students Only"), The Battalion and the Texas Engineering Extension Service; and Christy Kelm Murphy of Hamilton who worked for The Battalion, the High School Communications Workshop and the Department of Agricultural Communications.

Ennis gets third in frisbee bout

Robert Ennis of Houston placed third in the Men's Division of the First Intercollegiate Frisbee Championship, last Friday at Northwestern University in Evanston, Ill. Combined scores in distance and accuracy determined place of finish. This championship was the culmination of campus competition at 956 college and university recreation centers across the country. Ennis and 31 other finalists had won campus tournaments and then the regional level before coming to Evanston for the finals.

Phi Kappa Phi chooses Lacy

Robert A. Lacy of Lake Charles, La., was named winner

of the Phi Kappa Phi scholastic honor society's outstanding junior award at Texas A&M University last night.

Lacy, a physics major, received the \$500 award at the annual initiation banquet of the Texas A&M chapter of Phi Kappa Phi. About 480 students and six faculty members were initiated at the program. The outstanding junior award winner was drawn from 10 candidates, all of whom were designated as the outstanding juniors in their academic colleges.

Snyder receives Reynolds award

James Clark Snyder, a junior from Bowie, Maryland, has been

named regional winner of the 1977 annual Reynolds Alumni Prize for Architectural Student.

Administered by the American Institute of Architects, the prize is awarded for the creative use of aluminum in an original architectural design. Using aluminum as a structural and aesthetic element, Snyder designed a 440-square-foot triangular split level unit that accommodates four people. The competition was established in 1961 to encourage creativity in architectural design and to stimulate interest in the design potential of aluminum.

Snyder, an environmental design student, was awarded a certificate and a \$300 check from Reynolds.
