

# Faculty work load to be monitored

Faculty work loads will be monitored by a watchdog committee beginning September 1, 1977.

Established by the 65th Texas Legislature, the committee will consist of three members of the House to be appointed by the

lieutenant governor and three members of the Senate appointed by the speaker, said Rep. Bill Presnal of Bryan.

"The legislature's concern has caused departments to take another look at themselves and caused them to be more careful," said Presnal.

"The legislature felt institutions hadn't been complying with old policies, generally," Cherry explained.
