

# Pakistani army takes over government, jails officials

NEW DELHI, India — The Pakistani army yesterday overthrew the government in the world's third largest democracy and jailed political leaders including Prime Minister Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, Radio Pakistan said.

The radio said martial law was imposed throughout the nation as the army staged the coup, apparently to squash four months of political violence that has left more than 100 persons dead and thousands injured.

A Radio Pakistan broadcast monitored in New Delhi quoted an unidentified army spokesman as saying the situation was "normal, and peace and tranquility prevailed everywhere" in the Moslem nation of 75 million. The largest democracies are India and the United States.

The radio said Bhutto and other leaders of his Pakistan Peoples party, as well as leaders of the opposition Pakistan National Alliance, had been put under "temporary protective custody."

Pakistan's 30-year history has been marked by political instability. The military first assumed power in a 1958 coup and ruled until 1971 when Bhutto took office.

The latest coup came a day after a breakdown in negotiations between Bhutto and opposition leaders on new parliamentary elections that had been expected Oct. 7.

The four months of violence was sparked by Pakistan National Alliance charges that Bhutto and his party used massive vote fraud to win the March 7 parliamentary elections.

# HEW reports increase in ineligible aid cases

WASHINGTON — Texas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Colorado and Wyoming were among 18 states recording increases in ineligible Aid to Families with Dependent Children recipients during the six months ending in December, HEW said yesterday.

Government efforts to find bureaucratic blunders have reduced the mistakes, but nearly one in four welfare families still are ineligible or improperly paid, HEW said.

There was a 23.3 per cent "error rate" in Aid to Families with Dependent Children, the nation's largest welfare program, a HEW report said. The rate was 26 per cent for all welfare cases a year ago.

During the period ending last December, HEW said, 798,600 of the 6 million families getting welfare aid were ineligible or paid incorrectly.

HEW has said previously that welfare agencies or social workers

make 51 per cent of the errors and recipients the rest. How much represents actual cheating never has been determined, but fraud prosecutions represent less than 1 per cent of all cases.

The report said 5.3 per cent of the 11.2 million AFDC recipients were ineligible, 13.1 per cent were overpaid and 4.9 per cent were underpaid.

The District of Columbia had the highest proportions both of ineligible recipients, 15.3 per cent, and overpaid recipients, 23.2 per cent. Indiana had the lowest percentage of ineligible recipients, 0.9, and Nevada the lowest percentage of overpaid recipients, 1.9.

A federal court rules last year in a suit brought by several states and counties that HEW's method of determining penalties for states falling short of the goals was invalid. At that time, welfare officials said the deadline for meeting the 13 per cent goal was "unrealistic."
