A&M medical school selects first students

The state's newest medical school, Texas A&M University's College of Medicine, announced Wednesday the selection of its first students. They average two years younger than the national norm for beginning medical students and rank higher scholastically.

Dr. William E. Ward, the college's associate dean for student affairs said the average age in the 32-member class was 20 and an average grade point ratio of 3.83, based on a 4-point system. The mean average is 3.55 nationally and 3.48 for Texas.

Women comprise 21 percent of the class which starts Aug. 22. Texas A&M's medical school has been formed over the past years in association with Baylor College of Medicine, Scott Memorial Hospital and the Health Administration.

Texas A&M's medical school students may be accepted to begin their medical studies by receiving their undergraduate degrees. Under the Texas A&M concept, students will follow a clinical curriculum during would normally be their and/or senior years on the Texas A&M campus and then continue with the clinical part of their medical education in years at locations away from Station, including Scott and Temple and VA hospitals in Waco or Marlin.

Fourteen of the acceptees completed their undergraduate work last year, while 16 are in their junior and senior years.
