This will mark the first All-Star starting appearances for Randolph, Burleson and Zisk. Burleson, with 2.221,349 votes, edged out New York's Bucky Dent by only 3,426 in the closest race since 1972 when Don Kessinger of the Chicago Cubs defeated the New York Mets' Bud Harrelson by 3,000 votes as the National League's shortstop.

Randolph, with 2,846,479 votes, outdistanced Milwaukee's Don

Money by some 800,000 votes.


