The GraeterVision camera, which gives the viewer the same vantage point as the subject of the film, was developed by Jean Graeter. It enables a photographer to film, for example, open heart surgery through the eyes of the surgeon.

A valuable training tool, it had prosaic beginnings when the late Ralph Graeter, as art director for Life Magazine, was frustrated by the inability of photography to record, for instance, an auto mechanic at work through the mechanic's eyes, Jean Graeter said in an inter-Mrs. Graeter, whose interest in

electronics dates back to high school when she bought a model-T Ford in parts and put it together, "batted the idea around with my husband and little by little we came up with a working model. They formed First Person Prodaction Inc., with the idea of creating

unique films using their system to prove its value to schools, hospitals and industry.
Graeter died suddenly in 1975, before the idea they had formulated ould be carried out.

But we had discussed the possibilities of GraeterVision, and it had become almost a crusade with Mrs. Graeter said.

Following her husband's death, he was a brilliant man and a beautiful person" she continued to work and redesigned the system for greater portability and broader use. 
