Gasoline available for weekend travel

WASHINGTON — Motorists planning trips over the long Labor Day holiday weekend will pay less for gasoline than they did over the Fourth of July weekend, according to the American Automobile Association.

The association said a survey of 3,910 service stations around the country showed gas prices have dropped one-half to nine-tenths of a cent per gallon in the past two months.

The average cost of a gallon of regular gasoline over the upcoming holiday weekend will be 63.7¢. Premium will sell for an average 68.8¢, unleaded for 66.9¢ and diesel for 56.6¢, AAA said. Most service stations will be closed and gas supplies will be limited, the survey showed.

The association survey indicates the lowest gas prices in the country are in the Southwest, where gas is selling for 60.8¢, and in the Midwest for 65.5¢ and unleaded for 61.7¢ a gallon.
