English professor Frank Peirce, the state's most prolific adult mystery writer, has been honored for the seventh time by the Honor Roll of Best Detective Stories of the Year, a compilation considered the creme de la creme of the genre.

Peirce's inclusions this year was based on his short story "Time Bomb" which appeared last fall in Ellery Queen's Mystery Magazine.

"Time Bomb" was the 14th story of his to be accepted by the magazine. It will be translated into Dutch, said the writer and

teacher who is about to begin his 31st year at Texas A&M University.

Aerospace engineering senior Robert L. Winkler of San Antonio has been honored for his contributions to the 1975 Apollo-Soyuz Test Project while he was a Texas A&M University co-op student.

Winkler held cooperative education positions at NASA's Johnson Space Center during the world's first international space flight.

NASA presented Winkler and

other project members a medallion and document in both Russian and English carrying the signatures of three American astronauts.

Prof. Charles Roderick Wilson, his brothers and sister, Texas A&M and director of engineering co-op program. Winkler has agreed to accept the medallion he displayed at the Aerospace Engineering Department offices.

Winkler is the son of the late W. Winkler family, 422 E. Gregg, San Antonio.
