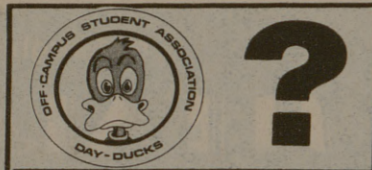

# Six (weekend) ways to keep from studying

★Visit the Mexican pastry shop at 304 N. Bryan in old downtown Bryan. Martinez Pastry features Mexican pastries, barbecue, Spanish records and books, cooking products and pinatas. Try the pineapple empanadas, or be brave and try the sweet potato pastry.

★Put some of your pastries in a picnic basket and take a drive in the country to Round Top, the smallest incorporated town in Texas. With a population of 27, Round Top is nestled in green, rolling hills with plenty of trees giving ample shade for eating and snoozing. There's a general store in the old tradition that has everything. The restored homes and public square are epitomes of quaintness. Go through Caldwell to Giddings on Hwy. 21, then look at the map. It's impossible to explain on paper.

★Sit through four hours of James Bond. Aggie Cinema is showing "Thunderball" and "To Russia With Love" Friday night. "Goldfinger" and "You Only Live Twice" showings are being moved from Saturday night to Sunday night to allow for the A&M-TexasTech football game viewing at G. Rollie White Coliseum. Both series begin at 8 p.m.

★Dance to "Breakaway" at the Lakeview Club Friday night. Breakaway is rock-n-roll, not Lakeview's usual fare.

★If you weren't lucky enough to get tickets to the Aggie-Texas Tech football game in Lubbock, there's one consolation. You can view the game live and in color, courtesy of a closed-circuit broadcast sponsored by the Class of '78 and the Texas A&M Athletic Department.

Student tickets with IDs are \$3 and date tickets are \$5. Tickets will be on sale Thursday and Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at G. Rollie White Coliseum. The coliseum doors will open at 6:30 p.m. for the showing. The game will be shown on a 12-by-15-foot screen. Refreshments will be available.

★If none of these excite you, polish your boots and visit the All-Youth Rodeo at the Brewton County Fair at the Brewton Fairgrounds. Exhibits open at 3 a.m. Friday and a dance by Dennis Ivey and the Way will be held at 8 that night. The rodeo also begins at 8 p.m.

Saturday things get started with a barbecue cookoff at 1 p.m. and a tobacco-spitting contest at 3 p.m. Then, either watch the rodeo or go to the dance and listen to Tommy Overstreet and the Nashville Express at 8 p.m.
