Flags—sew what

The waves of blue, gold, red, maroon and white flutter in the breeze as the Corps of Cadets enter Kyle Field. The satin and peau de soie fabrics glimmer in the sun.

Most of the guidons, which are the flags carried by each outfit and staff in the Corps, are made by one woman.

Mrs. T. G. Gorbet has been making them for 20 years. Her first one was handmade with the help of her employer, Tilley Hollis.

Hollis owned an alteration shop at Northgate when some of the cadets asked if the seamstress would make a guidon for their company.

"Even though it was made entirely by hand, it turned out pretty good," Mrs. Gorbet said of the flag. The next two were also hand-sewn; but now she does them all by machine.

Mrs. Gorbet said the most difficult job she ever had was a guidon for "Spider D" Company a few years ago. The 54 inch by 54 inch flag had a black spider on white satin.

"After the boys had already paid me, they were told they couldn't use it in the parade," she said.

Each time a new outfit is formed, members design a guidon.

Gorbet recently finished a new naval outfit.

Not all of the guidons are units. Some are made to represent worn ones and some are made on.

The seamstress usually spends a week to complete a guidon.

"It takes me all day just to sew letters and emblems and then I said, 'Then it all has to be done.'"

Only once has Mrs. Gorbet made a noticeable error.

"I sewed a letter on the wrong way and nobody caught it until the boys got it on campus," she said. "They were a little embarrassed, but I was glad I did."

Gorbet doesn't make all the guidons for the 57 outfits and staff in the Corps.

"Some of the units order ready-made and occasionally the boys' mothers make them," she said.

But it is safe to say she has made most of them. Last year she made 38 guidons, which is more than she ever made before in a single year.

"I have no idea how many have been made all together," Gorbet said. "But it's quite a number."




