## Hero recalls fatal blaze

The supper club exploded in flames and 164 people were killed during the early show. Sabino, a Cincinnati fire captain who was waiting in line when the fire broke

out, saved 20 to 30 persons.
"It's kind of a chilling thought,"
he said. "We would have been in
that room when the fire broke out if she had gotten those tickets.

Sabino reminisced about the fire Tuesday while in Denver to receive the Benjamin Franklin Award for saving the diners. The 43-year-old officer was honored at a convention of the International Association of Fire Chiefs.

'It's a shame that something like this has to happen before people think about such dangers, Sabino. "But it wasn't long after the fire that we checked out a Cincinnati nightelub and found an exit blocked. No one seemed to care.'

Sabino, who has been a fireman for 21 years, was waiting in a corridor with his wife, Dorothy, their 20-year-old son, Peter, and his girlfriend, when the fire broke out. A hostess ushered them outside and told them about the blaze
