Retardation center gets education grant

The Brazos Valley Mental Health-Mental Retardation Center has received a grant from the Texas Commission on Alcoholism to continue their community alcoholism education program.
The \$23,530 grant is being used by the Brazos Valley MH-MR Center to make information on alcoholism available to the public. Now in its third year, the program

used television and radio announcements, printed handouts and presentations to clubs, schools and other groups to reach the community.

A program for people convicted of driving while intoxicated (DWI) is presented to help the convicted drivers. The programs are conducted for probation officers in the seven counties served by the center.

"Emphasis is placed on responsible conduct, responsible drinking or being responsible enough not to drive and drink," said James Harris, counselor at the center. While the DWI classes do not attempt to "rehabilitate" people with drinking

problems, help is available for those who feel they need it.

"We have a phone number who people can call 24 hours a day (809-33) for help with alcoholism," Harris. After a person has asked help, we can provide him with personal counseling," he said.

"Sometimes we refer a person to Alcohol Anonymous or to his doctor for help," said Toni Nowlin, director of the center's chemical abuse programs.

The Brazos Valley MH-MR Center makes help available for people with drinking problems. At times, the Brazos Valley MH-MR Center is contacted by the family employer of a person with alcohol-related problems.

"Sometimes," said Harris, "a person will hear one of our public announcements, and is able to help himself."
