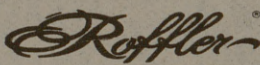

What's done is done

Coach Emory Bellard sounded like the writer of the lyrics "Look what they've done to my song ma" when describing how the Aggie offense executed the wishbone attack.

"You can have a well written song," Bellard explained. "But if the singer doesn't sing it to well, then no matter how good the song is, it will still sound lousy. We didn't sing too well in Michigan."

"I don't think our game plan was wrong, though. If we went back to Michigan this weekend, we would do better. It is my fault that we didn't perform up to our capabilities."

The Aggies have a week off to sharpen their playing skills. Waco and the Baylor Bears is the next stop on the current road engagement.

"This week we will concentrate on all aspects of our game," Bellard said. "We won't be worrying about Baylor until next Monday."

"We came out of the Michigan game in good shape physically. Jimmy Donahue is the most serious injury; he has a badly sprained ankle. Russel Mikeska has a pulled hamstring, but we expect him to be ready in the next few days."

George Woodard got a much needed workout in the Wolverine contest. Big George missed two weeks of practice, but made up for

this past weekend. He carried the ball 39 times for 153 yards.

"George was the most impressive guy in the Michigan game," Bellard said. "He needed the work badly, since he missed two weeks of workouts. He did a darn fine job."

But Woodard was just about the only one who did.

"After looking at the films you can tell that we had the opportunities," Bellard said. "We had lots of chances in the first half to gain that momentum which bounced around, but we just didn't do it. We had the plays to make, but we just didn't do it."

"When something like this happens then it is my fault. They just weren't as high for Michigan as they were for Texas Tech. I'll say one thing, we better be able to get up for each and every game from here on in. We have seven tough games in a row."

Over the next two months Bellard had better find something to loosen up opposing defenses. Michigan played the wishbone very well, but Bellard may have helped them by calling too conservative of a ball game. Twenty-two hindsight is the best coach in the world.

"You never can tell, but I should have gone for the touchdown instead of the field goal," Bellard, re-

ferring to a first quarter opportunity, said. "When you have a kicker like Tony Franklin it sometimes makes you think of the three instead of the seven."

"Anytime you are down in four down territory, you have got to

think of the touchdown. But all of this is twenty-twenty hindsight now. I just know that our football team is of the same caliber of Michigan's. We just didn't convert our opportunities."

The next seven opportunities are

the important ones for the Aggie. A&M wants to be in the Cotton Bowl, then they had better get the song right.

No more look what they've done to my song ma, or it will all just be out wrong.

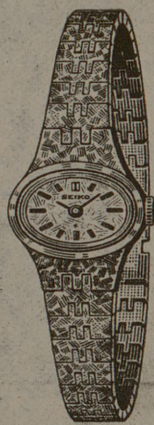

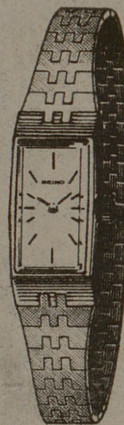

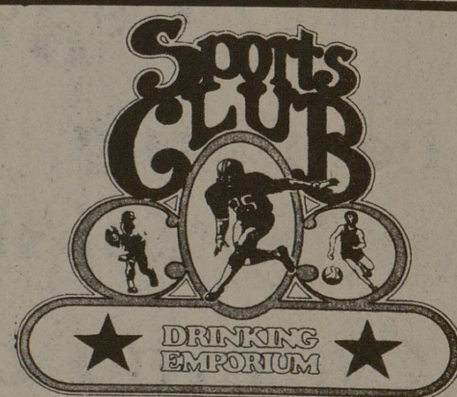
