## HEW finds bad claims

WASHINGTON — A government computer project to find cheating Medicaid doctors and druggists has been so successful it has been halted, HEW Secretary Joseph Califano told Congress Wednesday.

One source in the Department of Health, Education and Welfare said the search was at least temporarily stopped because "it's a matter of how many you can prosecute."

Project Integrity — originally called Project 500 because it was

aimed at turning up 500 doctors and druggists with suspicious claims for reimbursement — has turned up 1,400 doctors and 1,100 druggists, Califano told a Senate Health subcommittee.

"We've stopped at 2,500," he said of 50 persons singled out from each state as abusing funds for the needy.

An HEW spokesman said the 2,500 are the most flagrant apparent abusers among 47,000 turned up since Project Integrity was launched last April to examine Medicaid reimbursement claims during 1976.
