## Vet medicine dean wins annual award

Dr. George C. Shelton, Texas A&M University dean of veterinary medicine, has won the annual distinguished service award from the University of Missouri College of Veterinary Medicine. The honor recalls Shelton's 25 years of teaching, research, service and administration.

Shelton was associate dean of academic affairs at the Missouri veterinary college when he resigned in 1973 to become dean of veterinary medicine at Texas A&M.

The award was given during the fall conference of veterinarians held recently at the University of Missouri.

Pamela D. Morton, health and physical education instructor at Texas A&M University, teaches 214 students in her four beginning and one intermediate dance classes.

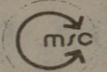

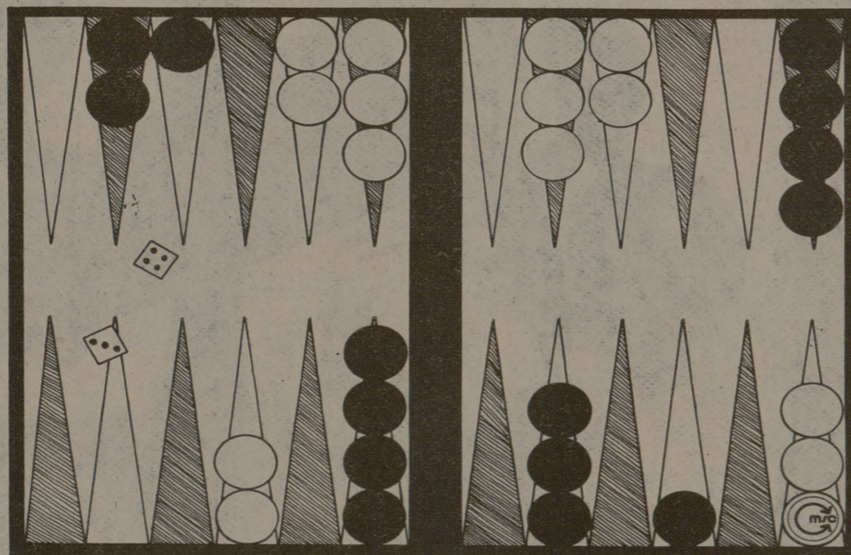

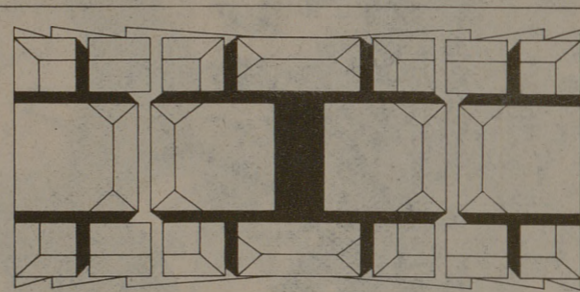
