

Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the Ring Clerk, Room Seven, Richard Coke Building, prior to November 10th. THIS MAY NOT BE DONE BY PHONE.

Bring mid-semester grade report along when ready to order to verify eligibility.

All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Senior Ring loans are available through student financial aid in the YMCA Building.

Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to being their mid-

advance and fail to bring their mid-senester grade report when ready to order will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked.

Mid-semester orders will be taken only from October 26th until November 30th,

NASA-made space suit lets boy explore world

"space suit" Thursday that has enabled David, an immunity deficient child, to hug his mother and walk outside. The child, whose last name has been witheld since his birth in a sterile environment, lacks the natural organisms which protect most people from minor infections and has never touched skin other than his own. Until NASA and Texas Children's

Hospital developed the \$20,000 rubber, plastic and nylon suit with a bubble helmet, he had never left the protective cells constructed at his home, in a van used to transport him and at the hospital.


