San Antonio plan trains unemployed

Skills center joins A&M system

A San Antonio center that trains the unemployed for entry into the work force will become part of the Texas Engineering Extension Service (EES).

The transfer to the Extension Service, part of the Texas A&M University System, has been approved by the Board of Regents. To be known as the San Antonio

Manpower Development and Training Center, the center will operate as a segment of EES' South Central Texas Regional Training Center.

The present San Antonio Skills Center has a staff of 60 and student enrollment of 600. The latter are in seven to nine-month training programs in a variety of job areas. The Texas Education Agency and city of San Antonio-funded center has been administered six years by the San Antonio Junior College District.

EES will become administratively responsible for the center Jan. 1, according to Director James R. Bradley.

Bradley said the Regional Training Center headquarters will be at

Hemisfair in city-provided quarters. The Regional Training Center will additionally house programs of the Extension Service divisions. The train people in construction, plumbing, electronics, fire protection, public works, supervisory development, law enforcement and other areas.

The Extension Service also operates regional training centers at other Texas locations. Transfer of the center has the backing of the San Antonio City Council and others.

Texas Education Agency will continue under a management contract with the Texas Engineering Extension Service.
