HOUSTON — A trend in gaso-  
line marketing to bigger  
service stations will be the  
knell for the proverbial "service"  
stations with which the motorist  
is most familiar.  
"The small dealer is going  
out," said William Olcott, ex-  
ecutive with National Petroleum News.  
Olcott predicts a doubling of  
share for self-service stations  
early 1980s.  
"Right now it's roughly 25  
percent. We're going to have that  
ble to 60 or 65 percent," he said.  
Olcott said self-service stations  
where washing your own wheels  
is almost impossible unless you  
your own cleaner and cloth —  
grow even more important.  
"We're going to have a large  
of land with maybe 10 islands  
self-serve," he said. "At one time
