Docking of Soyuz 26 lab success following failure

MOSCOW — Lt. Col. Yuri Romanenko, 33, and Georgi Grechko, 46, aboard the Soviet Union's Soyuz 26, docked with the orbiting space station Sunday, 25 hours and 43 minutes after the cosmonauts blasted off Saturday from the Baikonur launch site in Central Asia. The expedition may be preparation for a simultaneous docking of a second spacecraft.

Grinning broadly, flight engineer Grechko floated into the station and gestured to the television camera beaming his picture to earth.

"Can you see us better now?" asked ground control. The Salyut 6 lab has two extra and is designed to accommodate spacecrafts at the same time. The news agency said the two extra were important for crew change rescue operations, and food equipment deliveries.

The cosmonauts entered the station through a backup entrance, avoiding the problems faced by Soyuz 26 October mission that failed to dock with Salyut 6 at the other entrance. TASS said Grechko's first task was to check out the faulty docking system. Lt. Gen. Vladimir Shatalov, head of the Soviet cosmonaut training program, said he hopes that the docking of the cosmonauts would be completed successfully by the end of the year.
