FDA warns it's dangerous

WASHINGTON — The Food and Drug Administration Tuesday ordered the nation's druggist to tell women using birth control pills not to smoke because it substantially increases danger of heart attack or stroke.

The warning will be carried in a brochure and a leaflet which must be given each patient every time a druggist dispenses the

pill. The rules take effect April 3. 'The use of birth control pills by healthy women who do not smoke doubles the chance of suffering a heart attack," the FDA said. "But the combination of birth control pills and smoking, especially heavy smoking, presents a far greater risk of heart attack and other circulatory dis-
