

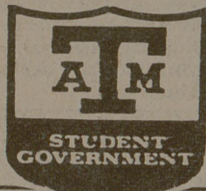

The College Scholarship Service Financial Aid Form serves as the financial aid application at this University. To insure that financial aid funds are available at the beginning of the academic periods below, the following deadline dates for filing the Financial Aid Form are announced for your information and appropriate action:

Summer Session (12 weeks, only)	January 1	January 15
An Academic Year	April 1	April 15
Fall Semester, Only	April 1	April 15
Spring Semester, Only	September 1	September 15

*The Financial Need Analysis Report is provided to this office by the College Scholarship Service and is based on information contained in the Financial Aid Form. Normal processing time for a Financial Aid Form at College Scholarship Service (including mail time) is about two (2) weeks. Therefore, you should mail your Financial Aid form to College Scholarship Service to allow sufficient time for proper processing and mail time.

Applicants for financial aid from Texas A&M University have to compete for limited funds. Deadlines are established so that all applicants are treated fairly and equally, without last minute haste. Financial Aid Forms submitted after the dates shown above will be processed only if time permits and funds are available.

Former patrolmen say he laughed at Torres

HOUSTON — A former patrolman testified Tuesday he "just laughed" at Joe Campos Torres' demand for a lawyer before the drunk Mexican-American was beaten and drowned while in police custody last year.

Glenn Brinkmeyer, 26, was one of five policemen fired after they arrested Torres May 5 on a barroom drunk complaint and the 23-year-old former Army paratrooper was found dead in Buffalo Bayou three days later.

Brinkmeyer has pleaded guilty to a misdemeanor civil rights violation and agreed to testify against Terry Denson, Stephen Orlando, Joseph Janish and Louis Kinney, who face possible life imprisonment on felony, civil rights charges.

"I just laughed," Brinkmeyer testified, when Torres demanded a lawyer. "If every one of the officers told the same story, there was not much he (Torres) could do about it," he said.

Federal prosecutors rested their case afterward. Defense was to begin today.

Under cross-examination, defense lawyers, Brinkmeyer's partner Louis Kinney, prevented the bayou incident they said was what started the body had been discovered and discussed the state could be involved," Brinkmeyer said in U.S. District Judge Ross' court.

Brinkmeyer said when started breaking he investigators his eyewitness and the incident, leaving out the details of the officers and Torres' friends of mine. I was still cover for them," he said.
