Texas A&M University... in three organizations will make their mark at Mardi Gras this weekend in New Orleans. Organizations to participate in several Mardi Gras events are the Texas A&M University Band, the Ross Volunteers, elite honorary unit, and the Women's Team and Fish Drill Team. Commanded by Bill Rademacher of Austin, the RVs are making their 27th consecutive appearance. This year will again be the lead unit in the parade on Tuesday. It has traditionally been the honor guard King Rex in the colorful parade of many through the French Quarter of the Gulf Coast city. Accompanied by three other RVs, the RVs will depart early Saturday morning for New Orleans. announced chief advisor Jake B. assistant to the commander. The Fish Drill Team and the Texas champion Women's Team is scheduled to leave at 5 a.m. today. The women, commanded by Susan Graesser Bryan, will march tonight in the Krewe of Jupiter Parade, one of the major parades associated with Mardi Gras among numerous other activities and events. The 20 marchers also will part in the Tulane Invitational Meet on Saturday in a competitive status. A team spokesman said the Tulane meet committee likes to see a team before a competition invitation is extended. The Women's Drill Team won the state title here last spring. The Tulane meet will open the Fish Drill Team's 1978 competitive season. It is one of the premier meets in the U.S.
