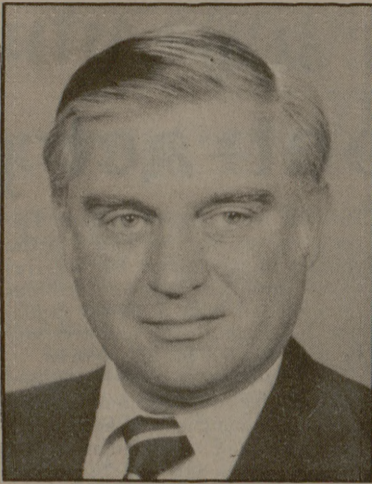

Cargill named director of new A&M department

Chuck Cargill has been named director of the newly created business services department, said Howard Vestal, vice president for business affairs at Texas A&M University. The new department, an outgrowth of the former management services department, will be the administrative coordinating unit for nine departments and auxiliary enterprises on campus, Vestal explained. Activities within the business services department include Food Services, University Center, Texas A&M Bookstore, married student housing and Easterwood Airport. It also includes the Printing Center, University Mail Services, dormitory administration, the golf course and a variety of miscellaneous services. They have a combine employment of some 1,300 persons.

"The name change of our services says more about what we are," said Cargill. "We are here to serve the students, faculty and staff. Hopefully, our reorganization will

provide us with more opportunities to do so."

Also announced in conjunction with formation of the new department were the appointments of Don Powell as assistant director and Bill Hensel as manager of the University Center.

Cargill was formerly director of the University Center. The 1953 Texas A&M business administration graduate joined the staff of his alma mater in 1961 as a counselor for the Corps of Cadets after serving as an area sales manager for Sears Roebuck and Co. He was named manager of the Exchange Store in 1965 and promoted to manager of the University Center in 1973. He earned a master's degree in business administration at Texas A&M in 1963.

Powell worked in operations management for J.C. Penny Inc. before returning to the university in 1973 as facilities manager for the University Center. He is a 1956 Texas A&M history graduate. He

earned a master's degree in educational administration in 1975.

Powell is vice president of the Texas Aggie Band Association and chairman of the C.K. Esten Theater Arts Award Committee.

Hensel, formerly assistant director for the University Center, received a B.A. in marketing from Texas A&M in 1941 and after five years of military service returned to join the university staff. He began his career here as assistant cashier and property accountant for the fiscal department, then served 13 years as assistant placement director and shortcourse director before becoming conference coordinator for the Memorial Student Center. He had been assistant director of the University Center since 1973.
