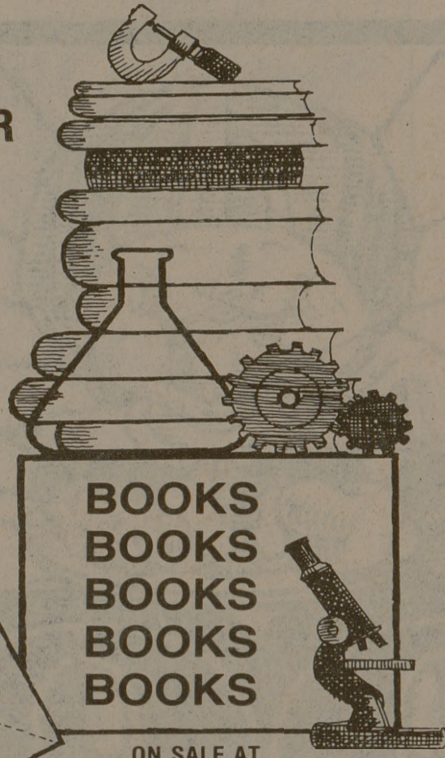

"Americans spend too much time watching television. Even I would get a soft head with all that television," Constantin Kuzminsky said Wednesday night. Kuzminsky is an exiled Russian poet and art critic.

The Memorial Student Center Arts Committee sponsored "Forbidden Arts from Leningrad,"

Wednesday at 8 p.m. in the Rudder Theater.

Kuzminsky said more modern American literature is poor quality. "Whitman and Hemingway are examples of American writers to be proud of," he said.

"All poetry is unpublishable in Russia," he said. Most of Kuzminsky's poems are based on the concept of freedom, he said.

NEW YORK — Monday's near-blizzard brought more than snow to the nation's largest city. It brought babies too.

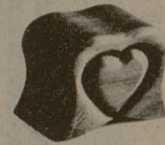
Puzzled doctors at one New York City hospital said twice as many

"The place has really been buzzing since midnight," said a spokeswoman for Long Island Jewish-Hillside Medical Center.

"We've delivered 16 babies since midnight and four mothers are in labor right now," she said shortly after 9 p.m. On a normal day, 10 babies are born at the hospital, she said.

Research funding highest ever in '77

Aid to research at Texas A&M University ended the 1977 calendar year at the highest level ever, figures from the University Research Office reveal.

Projects received \$751,198 during December, bringing the September-December cumulative for research funding to \$38,275,725. With eight months left in the current fiscal year, support is running \$5.75 million ahead of the same period last year.

In December, the College of Sci-

ence received \$214,138 and the College of Agriculture and Texas Agricultural Experiment Station shared \$183,942.

Other aid included \$151,776 to the College of Engineering, Texas Engineering Experiment Station and Texas Transportation Institute; \$114,975 for the College of Geosciences; \$45,642 for Moody College; \$23,325 for the College of Business Administration; \$15,000 for the College of Veterinary Medicine; and \$2,500 for the College of Liberal Arts.

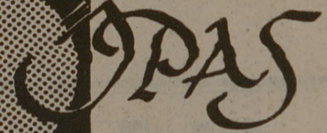
