## A&M receives \$30,000

Mr. and Mrs. John R. Blocker of Houston have endowed a \$30,000 Twelfth Man athletic scholarship at Texas A&M University.

Blocker is a 1945 Texas A&M graduate and a member of the Texas A&M University System board of regents.

The couple's gift was made through the Aggie Club, an organization dedicated to raising scholarship funds for the university's student

athletes. The Blockers have provided previous support to the Aggie Club's programs, as well as having furnished a \$25,000 President's Endowed Scholarship and donated funds for installation of the

twin 100-foot flagpoles at Kyle Field. The football stadium staff was placed in memory of Blocker's brother, the late William B. Blocker, also of Texas A&M's Class of '45, who died during World War II.

Blanchard named

director of center

Appointment of Dr. Bruce J. Blanchard as director of the Remote Sensing Center of Texas A&M has been announced by Harry E. Whitmore, Texas Engineering Experiment Station's associate director.

Blanchard has been an associate research engineer in the center and associate professor of agricultural engineering since 1975.

He succeeds Dr. John W. Rouse, who resigned to become head of electrical engineering at the University of Missouri at Columbia.

Blanchard becomes the second director of the Remote Sensing Center, which was organized in 1968. It is recognized as one of the leading research organizations in earth observations.

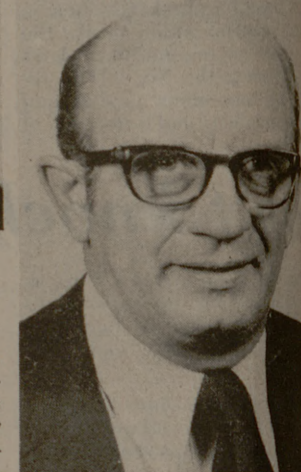
He is a native of Naples, N.Y., and graduated from Oklahoma State University in 1949. He earned advanced degrees in civil engineering and environmental science at the University of Oklahoma.

Blanchard has been involved in earth resources measurement and analysis of data from aircraft and spacecraft systems for the past nine years. He was formerly with the U.S. Department of Agriculture Research Service at Chickasaw, Okla. He worked in remote sensing applications in water resources and also as a hydraulic engineer with the USDA Southern Great Plains Watershed Center.

Blanchard is on the University Space Research Association's Science Committee for Earth Resources. The nine-member committee helps coordinate activities for universities involved in space research.

He is also the only university representative on the Seasat-Synthetic Aperture Radar Experiment Team. Blanchard will be responsible for land-related experiments with the system. Scheduled for launch in 1978, Seasat will carry the first radar

system for civilian use in space. Widely involved in cooperative and consulting work, Blanchard has served and worked in various capacities with NASA on space shuttle microwave systems, shuttle imaging radar and the Earth Resources Technology Satellite (Landsat).

Thomas becomes

new acting dean

Dr. Richard E. Thomas has been named acting dean of engineering at Texas A&M University, announced Dr. J.M. Prescott, vice president for academic affairs.

The appointment follows the naming of former Dean Fred Benson to the newly created position of vice president for engineering and non-renewable sources.

"We are extremely pleased to have a person of Dr. Thomas' qualifications and administrative experience to serve as acting dean," Prescott said recently. He is confident that he will provide strong leadership for the College of Engineering during this interim period.

Thomas has been associate dean of engineering since 1971 and his association with Texas A&M dates back to 1964. He taught and conducted research in the aerospace engineering department until 1969, when he accepted the chairmanship of the aerospace engineering department at the University of Maryland. He returned to Texas A&M in 1971.

In conjunction with his appointment as associate dean, Thomas has served as director of Texas A&M's center for urban programs.

He is a member of the Policy Advisory Committee of the Applied Research Program of the National Science Foundation and also serves on the National Academy of Engineering's Committee on Computer-aided Manufacturing. He holds four degrees from Ohio State University.

\*The Financial Need Analysis Report is provided to this office by the College Scholarship Service and is based on information contained in the Financial Aid Form. Normal processing time for a Financial Aid Form at College Scholarship Service (including mail time) is about two (2) weeks. Therefore, you should mail your Financial Aid Form to College Scholarship Service to allow sufficient time for proper processing and mail time.

Applicants for financial aid from Texas A&M University have to compete for limited funds. Deadlines are established so that all applicants are treated fairly and equally, without last minute haste. Financial Aid Forms submitted after the dates shown above will be processed only if time permits and funds are available.
