400 expected for pest control seminar

Pest control specialists from throughout Texas go into training today at Texas A&M University. They began registration Saturday for the 32nd Pest Control Workshop, a three-day mid-winter operators course conducted by the Texas Agricultural Extension Service. About 400 participants are expected.

"The workshop is about the only source of technical training for exterminators," said Dr. Philip Hamman, extension entomologist with TAEX and program coordinator.

Workshop sessions, providing in-depth treatment of current problem areas, will be instructed primarily by industry representatives. A Texas A&M specialist will speak on storing grain products.

Sessions will go into treatment of such problems as fleas and ticks, and handling vertebrate pests such as possums, raccoons, skunks and deer.

Well 'fracturing' training to begin

Training designed to help bring previously unproductive oil wells on line will be conducted Feb. 13-17 at Texas A&M University.

The short course on well stimulation — called fracturing — will involve 20 industry specialists, according to Dr. Douglas Von Conten. He heads the Petroleum Engineering Department which sponsors the course.

It is a first-time offering and "particularly applicable in this day and time of oil shortages," Von Conten said. Companies need every technical capability possible to increase production, he added.

The Hydraulic Fracture Treat-

ment Design Course was put together by Dr. Stephen Hollibaugh, the department. Instruction will be conducted by selected members of the petroleum engineering faculty.

Preliminary work will go into evaluation from its geology, log core analysis and testing prior to fracture, along with drilling completion parameters.

Most of the course will be on fracture treatment design, including calculations and selection of fluids and additives, fractured well performance and optimization.

Sessions will be conducted in W. T. Doherty Petroleum Engineering Building.

Safety engineers begin conference, awards

Representatives of the American Society of Safety Engineers' Region III will present funds for several scholarships to Dr. Richard Thomas, Texas A&M University's acting dean of engineering, tonight to highlight the first day of the group's conference here.

The presentation, during a 6:30 p.m. banquet in the Memorial Student Center, follows a day of addresses designed for persons with responsibilities in safety, occupational health and industrial hygiene.

The three-day program focuses on better equipping safety and health professionals by making them aware of engineering controls over potential hazards and by proper presentation and conduct in formal legal proceedings.

As part of the latter goal, a trial is scheduled for 10 a.m. Tuesday at Rudder Tower, on-campus headquarters.

About 70 professionals will be addressed by representatives of the Employers Insurance Co. of the Southwest Research Institute, Industries and Vinson & Elkins firm.

The conference also includes special discussion on placement protection of female workers.
