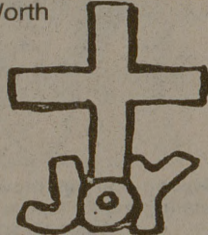

Therefore, you should mail your Financial Aid form to College Scholarship Service to allow sufficient time for proper processing and mail time.

Applicants for financial aid from Texas A&M University have to compete for limited funds. Deadlines are established so that all applicants are treated fairly and equally, without last minute haste. Financial Aid Forms submitted after the dates shown above will be processed only if time permits and funds are available.

'Slowhand' is a let down

Clapton follows rules

"Ol' Slowhand" is back, but it may be awhile before Eric Clapton faithfuls will admit it. His album of the same name shows marked improvement, but is still shy of his peak six years ago.

The lightning quick guitar master became a living legend while

singer but pairing her with Clapton sounds awkward. Mel Collins' double sax solo is impressive and Clapton's following solo is like something from his past, but the song is unfortunately situated in a pop-oriented present.

Clapton's attempt at a get-down blues number fails as "Mean Old Frisco" sounds like regurgitated ZZ Top. Clapton's voice here is like a dirty old man and his guitar sounds equally laborious. "Peaches & Diesel" is a prettier song, consisting of a delicate guitar riff, but a repititious lead. The tune never builds to anything as Clapton shows his complete mastery of three notes on what seems to be a very scratched record.

Clapton also tries a few folk tunes, but lacks the deft acoustic guitar work that is required. "May You Never" is too simple for Clapton to even consider. He sounds lucky to

live through "Next Time I'll Be Here." "Wonderful Tonight" has but lacks the intensity of momentum that spirited him to and perform classics like "Bell Bottom Blues."

Clapton depends too much on rules of success that accompany music, hoping that if he regains lyrics, leads and refrains that they'll be hits. And it works cause "Lay Down Sally" is a good one but only because the merit of Levy's backup vocal and the radio programmed refrain. It represents a gross misplacement of comparable to permitting Bernstein to play a Neil Young jingle.

Clapton's guitar is better, and his voice is far from acceptable. One can only hope that next time "Ol' Slowhand" he'll remember to bring everything else with him.

playing with the Yardbirds, Blind Faith, Derek and the Dominoes, and most notably, Cream. A heroin addiction halted his ascent however, and even his famous comeback "Rainbow Concert" arranged by the Who's Pete Townshend could do little to better the sound of Clapton's solo endeavors.

His albums since the classic "Layla" were just not what one might call typical Clapton. It's almost acceptable fact that guitar whizzes turn sour on their own LP's as shown by greats Stephen Stills, George Harrison, and even Peter Frampton after his live album.

Clapton follows the rule explicitly as he uses female vocalists to cover what is lacking in his own voice. He also uses Bruce Springsteen's "Born to Run" album cover concept to hide what he's lacking in originality.

The first cut "Cocaine" was written and released a year and a half ago by J.J. Cale, not by Clapton. Nevertheless, it's a good version as Clapton's fine guitar and hoarse voice duplicate Cale's rendition to the very note.

"The Core" is an eight-minute jam with Marcy Levy and Clapton trading vocals. Levy is a good soul
