

# Ag teams enjoyed prestigious debates

Members of the Texas A&M University Debate Team participated in two of the most prestigious Forensics Tournaments in the nation last week. Aggie Debate Teams debated at the Harvard Invitational Feb. 4, 5 and 6 and at the Dartmouth Invitational Feb. 7, 8 and 9.

The teams, mostly debaters in their first year of intercollegiate competition, won about 40 percent of their debates against high-powered varsity teams from throughout the country.

The TAMU debaters defeated teams from University of Virginia, Purdue, Boston College, Catholic University, MIT, Rutgers, St. Anselm, Western Washington and Emporia.

At the Harvard match, seventy-two member teams from 36 univer-

sities competed. The Dartmouth competition involved 28 universities and about 50 teams.

Becky Parks, sophomore electrical engineering major and Michael Shelby, freshman finance major, were given an invitation to the Northwestern Tournament this week on the basis of their records at Harvard and Dartmouth.

The Northwestern Tournament is one of the largest in the country with 128 2-person teams registered.

Other teams participating in the Harvard and Dartmouth tournaments were: Eric Copeland, a sophomore nuclear engineering major and Jeff Perkins, an electrical engineering major, David Dally, a sophomore finance major and Scott Brown, a sophomore ocean engineering major.
