Officer Karen Schluter, one of the men officers, said she has never ad anyone question her authority as campus officer, but has had one cident where she was questioned cause she is a female

She plained, "He brought it back in the ffice after I finished writing it and alked to my lieutenant. He just dn't want to take it because I was a


