

Nobel prize winner to visit

Nobel Prize winner Dr. George Palade heads the list of visitors and speakers on the Texas A&M University campus this week.

Also coming are students competing in the Junior Invitational Drill Meet and Rifle Matches, the Texas and Southwestern Cattleman's Association, the College of Agriculture's American Oat Workers' Conference, the Human Nutrition Workshop and the Basic Course of Instruction in Industrial Development.

Nobel winner Palade will present lecture on "Intercellular Aspects of Protein Secretion" at 2 p.m. Thursday in Rudder Theater.

The Romanian-born scientist won the 1974 Nobel Laureate in Medicine for his cellular research. It topped numerous other awards including the 1966 Albert Lasker Basic Research Award and the 1970 Hurwitz Prize.

The Great Issues Committee of the Memorial Student Center (MSC) will present two speakers next week.

Drs. Rita and Blair Justice will be speaking on "Child Abuse in America" at 12:30 p.m. Thursday in MSC.

Drill Field, where all competition will be held. Rifle match awards are planned shortly after firing ends at 4 p.m. Sunday.

A master trophy, the Texas A&M Award for Excellence, will go to the school with the best combined results in both the meet and matches, along with separate awards in each. The Texas and Southwestern Cattleman's Association brings more than 400 ranchers to campus Thursday through Saturday. The conference is hosted by the Animal Science Department.

The American Oat Workers' Conference Monday and Tuesday is sponsored by the Department of Soil and Crop Sciences. The conference is expected to bring some 100 people to the University. Meetings will be in 301 Rudder Tower.

The drill meet, to decide the Texas state champion men's and women's teams, will have 41 entries. Schools from across Texas and Louisiana will be represented in both events.

The drill awards ceremony will be 5:30 p.m. Saturday on the MSC

The Human Nutrition Workshop, sponsored by the Texas Agriculture Extension Service, also expects 100. The workshop runs Monday through Friday in 302 Rudder Tower.


H.B. Zachry, president of the H.B. Zachry Co., will speak to the Texas A&M Society of Women Engineers at 7:30 p.m. Monday in the Zachry Engineering Center, which bears his name.

The Basic Course in Industrial Development will be held Monday through Saturday. Eighty persons are expected to attend the course, sponsored by the Industrial Economics Research Division. Meetings will be in 501 Rudder Tower.

The Association of General Contractors will be meeting at 7 p.m. Tuesday in 301 Rudder Tower. Some 100 people are expected to attend.
