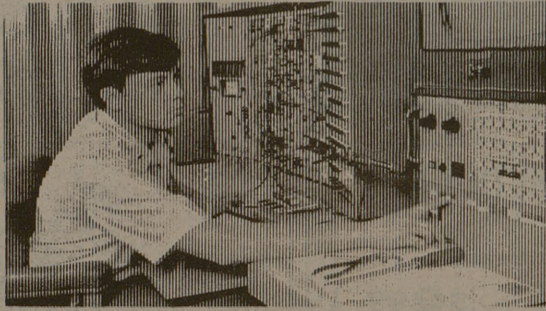


Three trash fires break out in dorms

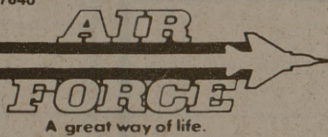

The College Station Fire Department reported trash fires in three Texas A&M University dormitories late Wednesday night and early Thursday morning.
The first fire which started in the trash chute on the third floor of the Landon Hall was reported at 9:45 p.m. by the physical plant dispatcher, said Fire Chief Douglas Landua.
The fire was large enough to trigger sprinklers in the trash chutes, Landua said. Residents of the dorm used a garden hose to help firemen extinguish the blaze. Smoke and water damage were so slight that Landua could not place a monetary value on them.
The second fire was reported in

Dunn Hall at 11 p.m. when residents of the men's dorm complained of smoke in their rooms. This fire also started in the trash chute and was extinguished before firemen arrived.
A third fire which started in the first floor trash chute of Hughes Hall was reported by the plant dispatcher at 12:31 a.m. Thursday, Landua said.
Firemen's efforts to put out the fire were hampered by steel poles that blocked the fire engine from driving to the front of the dorm, Landua said. The poles are across Henderson Street to keep Hughes residents from parking in front of the dorm. Firemen had to cut a chain link to remove a pole from its socket before they could drive the engine near the dorm, Landua said.
