1976. These facilities are to benefit all citizens of our community, and to have this benefit, some expenses are going to be incurred. Do you see any problems with the


current zoning code? Would you consider new areas for construction?

The sixth edition of a thermodynamics textbook used at Texas &M University for more than 40 ears has been released by MacMiln Publishing Co.

Revisions were done by Clifford Faires. Contributing to subsequent I. Simmang, a former Texas A&M revisions and a second volume,

mechanical engineering professor. "Thermodynamics" was first pub-lished in 1935, and was based on materials prepared for Texas A&M courses by the late Dr. Virgil M.

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
