Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to bring their ndi-Semester Grade Report along when ready to order will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked.

All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Senior Ring Loans are available through Student Financial Aid in the YMCA Building.

Mid-Semester orders will be taken only from March 22nd until April 28th, 1978.

Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. (Whenever 92 hours have been completed and are on record, there is never a dead-line, except a

ord, there is never a dead-line, except a monthly mailing date on which we send orders to the factory).

The Ring Clerk is on duty from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day, Monday through Friday. However, in order for other duties to be carried out, Absolutely no orders will be taken between 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. or between 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. All rings ordered, regardless of whether on March 22nd or April 28th, will be delivered on the same day which will be approximately June 29, 1978.


