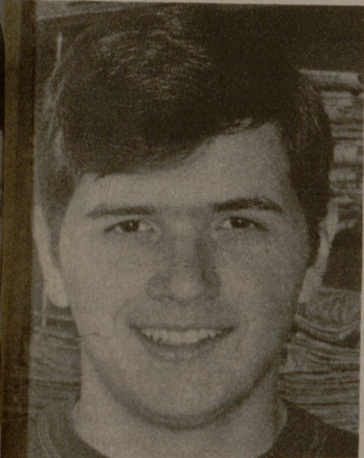

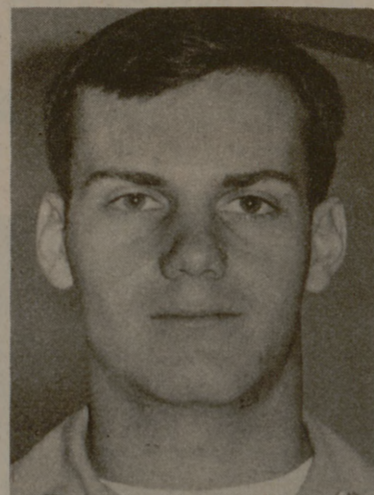

No. I feel all sports are beneficial to all involved in them and also to those who are not. I feel if a yell leader is not able to attend a major (see CRANDELL, page 8)



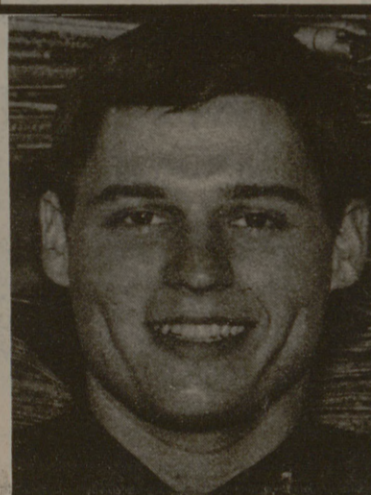

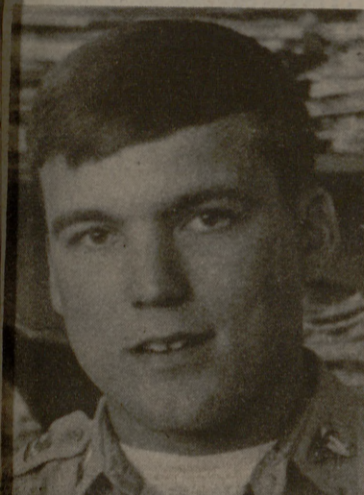

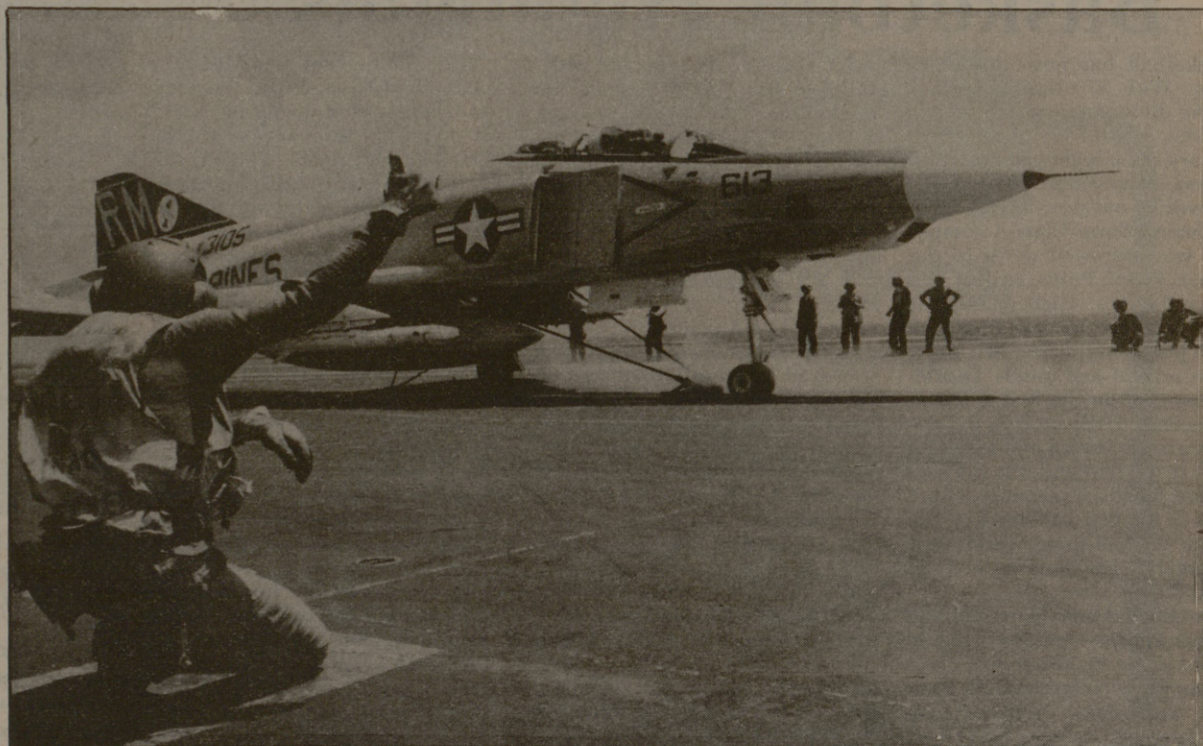
