### Jojoba production risky for farmers

EDITOR'S NOTE: This is the third of a three-part series.

A desert plant capable of producing a replacement for whale oil is years away from high commercial production, says a Texas A&M University plant scientist.

The plant, known as jojoba (ho-ho-ba), produces an oil almost identical to the oil of the endangered sperm whale.

Current efforts to increase production of jojoba in the wild continue, but until more is known about the plant, few of America's farmers can risk the gamble of growing an unknown crop.

"From what I know, if you can produce it, you can sell it," says Dr. Charles Miller of Texas A&M. "The problem is that it takes three years to get the plants up. If you're lucky, it will be five years before there is any sizable production acreage."

The U.S. Congress currently has a \$60 million bill under consideration for research and development of oil producing plants similar to jojoba.

"Our first step at Texas A&M is to find the exact conditions that grows best under, what disease affect it and the rainfall required for maximum production," Miller says. "We will set out a plot this spring from cutting a sizable gamble, but we're on the right road in this learning process."

"There is not enough information known about the plant, so producers will be asking questions about growing the plant and going to have to have the answers. Right now, we don't even have a first disease report."

"In the past, all scientists had to work with is planting in the wild. Hopefully, our work at Texas A&M will change that."

**SENIOR RING ORDERING PROCEDURE For Students Completing 92 Hours at the End of the Spring '78 Semester**  
To be eligible to order the Texas A&M Senior Class Ring, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the University. To order at mid-semester using mid-semester grades to fulfill the above requirements, please note the following instructions:

1. Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the Ring Clerk, Heaton Building, prior to Spring Break if possible, or at least one week in advance of ordering. This may not be done by phone.
2. Bring Mid-Semester Grade Report along when ready to order to verify passing hours.
3. Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to bring their Mid-Semester Grade Report along when ready to order will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked.
4. All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Senior Ring Loans are available through Student Financial Aid in the YMCA Building.
5. Mid-Semester orders will be taken only from March 22nd until April 28th, 1978.
6. Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. (When other duties have been completed and are on record, there is never a dead-line, except a monthly mailing date on which we send orders to the factory.)
7. The Ring Clerk is on duty from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., each day, Monday through Friday. However, in order for other duties to be carried out, Absolutely no orders will be taken between 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. or between 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.
8. All rings ordered, regardless of whether on March 22nd or April 28th, will be delivered on the same day which will be approximately June 29, 1978.
