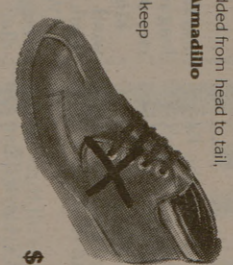

**A&M's Saddle and Sirloin Club
will participate in livestock show**

The Texas A&M University Saddle and Sirloin Club will hold the Little Southwestern Livestock Show Saturday.

Members of the club will compete in showing cattle, horses, sheep and swine.

Contestants will show animals that they worked with from the livestock centers.

"This year we will have about 100 contestants," said club president Bruce Nesloney.

Competition will begin at 7 a.m. Sunday at the University's swine center. After the swine contest the contestants will show sheep, horses and cattle in that order at the respective centers.

A champion and reserve champion will be selected from each livestock specie. In the afternoon, these eight individuals will compete against each other for the grand champion and reserve grand champion showmanship honors at the Animal Pavilion. They will have to show an animal from all four species," Nesloney said.

There will be awards given to the overall top six freshmen.

There will be different judges for each class. All four will select the grand and reserve grand showmanship champions.

"We've been having this contest for a long time," said Nesloney.

**Tame timber wolf
truly 'one man pet'**

MONTPELIER, Vt. — Edward Wallin said the first two weeks with his pet female timber wolf were rough, but now the hard times are over and he would like to keep her permanently.

"It's strictly a one-man wolf," Wallin said.

The state Fish and Game Board is expected to act on the 31-year-old Sandgate resident's application for permission to keep the wolf this week. Wallin said he isn't too optimistic and added he anticipates a hard fight.

Wallin said he bought the wolf named Sharika, for \$750 from a breeder in North Carolina. The animal is not dangerous and is afraid of strangers.

During his first two weeks with Sharika, she was frightened of her new surroundings and bit him several times, Wallin explained, and then the fighting stopped.

Although Sharika rips free several hours at a time, Wallin said she does not venture far from the remote cabin he rents in rugged southern Vermont.

Despite Wallin's contention, the animal has caused no problems, he conceded. It has generated concern among townspeople, and his hand-lady has threatened to evict him and his wolf.

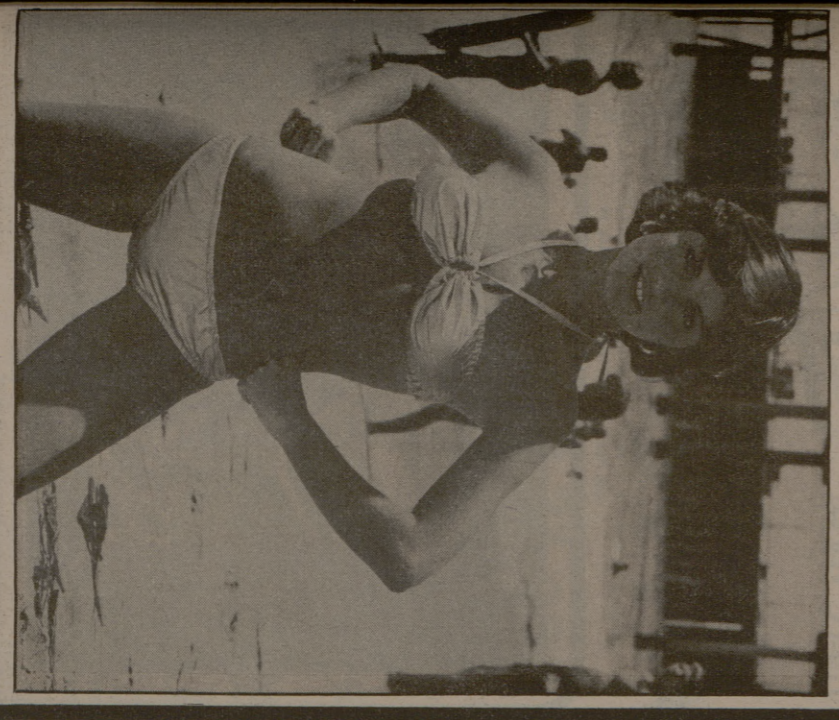
