Student captured after shot, siege

A student, 17, dressed in a Nazi uniform fired a shot into the ceiling of a Southwest Colorado high school Thursday.
The student was captured by police several hours later as he tried

to escape from the building.
The youth, identified by police as Kirk Kemp, a junior student at Montezuma-Cortez High School, resisted for five hours all efforts to persuade him to surrender, including pleas from his family and school

officials.
No one was injured in the incident, including the teenager, who school officials said had previously expressed an interest in the Nazi philosophy.
"There is speculation he might have been influenced by watching 'Holocaust,'" school superintendent Robert Howerton said.
The four-part television program which concluded Wednesday night portrayed the Nazi treatment of Jews before and during World War II.
Howerton said the incident began shortly before the opening of classes. The youth, walking in a classroom and fired a shot into the ceiling, he said.
"The gun was a Luger-type pistol," Howerton said. "Those who talked with him said he had no intention of hurting anybody. They were worried he might hurt himself."
The superintendent said the youth had never been a serious discipline problem at the school.
The youth's father, a construction engineer, was working in the Window Rock, Ariz. area but returned to Cortez when he was informed of the situation. He, his wife and the boy's brother all failed to talk him into surrendering.

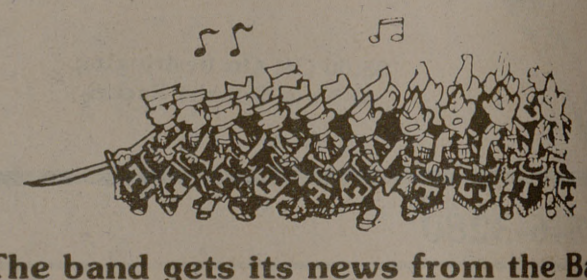

<p>OFFICIAL NOTICE</p> <p>SENIOR RING ORDERING PROCEDURE For Students Completing 92 Hours at the End of the Spring '78 Semester To be eligible to order the Texas A&M Senior Class Ring, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the University. To order at mid-semester using mid-semester grades to fulfill the above requirements, please note the following instructions: 1. Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the Ring Clerk, Heaton Building, prior to Spring Break if possible, or at least one week in advance of ordering. This may not be done by phone. 2. Bring Mid-Semester Grade Report along when ready to order to verify passing hours. 3. Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to bring their Mid-Semester Grade Report along when ready to order will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked. 4. All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Senior Ring Loans are available through Student Financial Aid in the YMCA Building. 5. Mid-Semester orders will be taken only from March 22nd until April 28th, 1978. 6. Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. (Whenever 92 hours have been completed and are on record, there is never a dead-line, except a monthly mailing date on which we send orders to the factory.) 7. The Ring Clerk is on duty from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day, Monday through Friday. However, in order for other duties to be carried out, absolutely no orders will be taken between 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. or between 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. 8.
