WASHINGTON — The Federal Trade Commission - already waging an attack on sugar-laden TV commercials aimed at children - is going after comic books.

The agency announced Thursday it is opening an industry-wide investigation of comic book advertising to determine if children are being readers are being suckered into buytricked or deceived by the kinds of ads carried in them

In addition it said it wants to know if it's deceptive to use comic book characters or personalities to push products on the pages of the same books in which they cavort.

The FTC's Seattle regional office, which will conduct the investigation to determine if some action needs to be taken, said preliminary estimates indicate that \$5 million a month is being spent on comic book advertis-

In addition it said the industry estimates that 92 percent of children between the ages 8 and 10, and 82 percent of those between the ages of 5 and 7, are comic book readers.

It also said preliminary studies indicate 25 percent of the average


