SENIOR RING ORDERING PROCEDURE
For Students Completing 92 Hours at the End of the Spring '78 Semester

To be eligible to order the Texas A&M Senior Class Ring, an undergraduate student must have at least ninety-two (92) semester hours, with 30 hours at A&M and be in good standing with the University. To order at mid-semester using mid-semester grades to fulfill the above requirements, please note the following instructions:

1. Leave your name, major and I.D. number with the Ring Clerk, Heaton Building, prior to Spring Break if possible, or at least one week in advance of ordering. This may not be done by phone.
2. Bring Mid-Semester Grade Report along when ready to order to verify passing hours.
3. Anyone having failed to leave their name in advance and fail to bring their Mid-Semester Grade Report along when ready to order will be asked to return later to allow time for records to be checked.
4. All rings must be paid for in full when the order is placed. Student Ring Loans are available through Student Financial Aid in the YMCA Building.
5. Mid-Semester orders will be taken only from March 22nd until April 28th, 1978.
6. Students who do not place their order during this period may order after final grades are posted. (Whenever 92 hours have been completed and are on record, there is never a dead-line, except a monthly mailing date on which we send orders to the factory.)
7. The Ring Clerk is on duty from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day, Monday through Friday. However, in order for other duties to be carried out, Absolutely no orders will be taken between 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. or between 4:00 - 5:00 p.m.
8. All rings ordered, regardless of whether on March 22nd or April 28th, will be delivered on the same day which will be approximately June 29, 1978.

Honors program pre-registration begins Monday

Pre-registration for the expanded fall 1978 University Honors Program will be held in conjunction with regular fall pre-registration Monday through Friday. Qualifying students have a larger choice than ever with departments offering 28 courses in 42 honors sections, more than twice the scope of the program year ago. Many of the honors sections are appropriate as electives outside the students' field of study, said Dr. B.L. Shapiro, director of the program. For the first time, the College of Agriculture is offering honors courses, and the College of Business Administration has entered the honors program with five courses in four departments. History of architecture is another new course added by the College of Architecture and Environmental Design. All departments in the College of Science are participating. Freshmen on the list as the first foreign language.

To qualify for an honors section, a current student must have a grade point ratio of 3.0 or above. Students interested in registering for the special courses should make sure their advisers plan them in sections with the designation "H".

Honors sections hold several advantages for students, Shapiro said. Among these are smaller class size, outstanding instructors, stimulating class environment, broader treatment of material and honors student classification on college transcripts. Although the material may require more work, officials emphasize that grades seldom suffer.
