BATON ROUGE, La. — It was 200 years late, but Louisiana state senators thanked France for military and financial help in the American Revolution.

Senators approved a resolution by Sen. Edgar Mouton, D.-Lafayette, to thank France for joining the 13 colonies in 1778 in a treaty that helped defeat the British in New York and Philadelphia.

"It's part of an international recognition to France on the anniversary of the treaty," Mouton said.

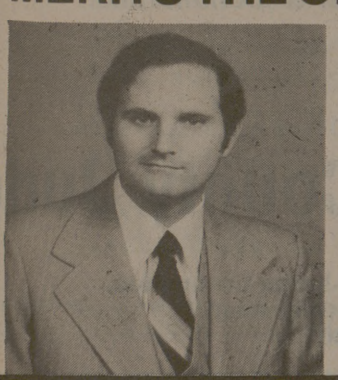
