Engineering college names top graduates

Mike Humphrey of Paris, Wayne Simmons of San Marcos and Tommy Yantis of San Antonio have been named outstanding graduating seniors in Texas A&M University's College of Engineering.

Engineering Senior Achievement Awards were presented at an engineering faculty meeting.

Faculty awards also were announced at the meeting presided over by Dr. Richard Thomas, acting dean.

Dr. Tim Coppinger, associate professor of engineering design

graphics, was presented the \$1,500 General Dynamics Teaching Award by CD project engineer Jim Vaughn. The firm has made the award 22 years at Texas A&M.

A similar award was presented professor of mechanical engineering, Allen Owings of the firm made the presentation. It was first given last year.

Bob Callaway, civil engineering professor, received the \$3,000 E.D. Brockett Professorship Award, funded by Gulf Oil Corp. Started in 1974-75, it is restricted for research, special study, writing or professional development by the recipient.

The senior achievement awards recognize scholastic ability, partici-

pation in student activities and financial responsibility as evidenced by percent of college expenses earned.

Yantis and Humphrey are graduating in civil engineering and Simmons, nuclear engineering.

Berthold named 'outstanding man'

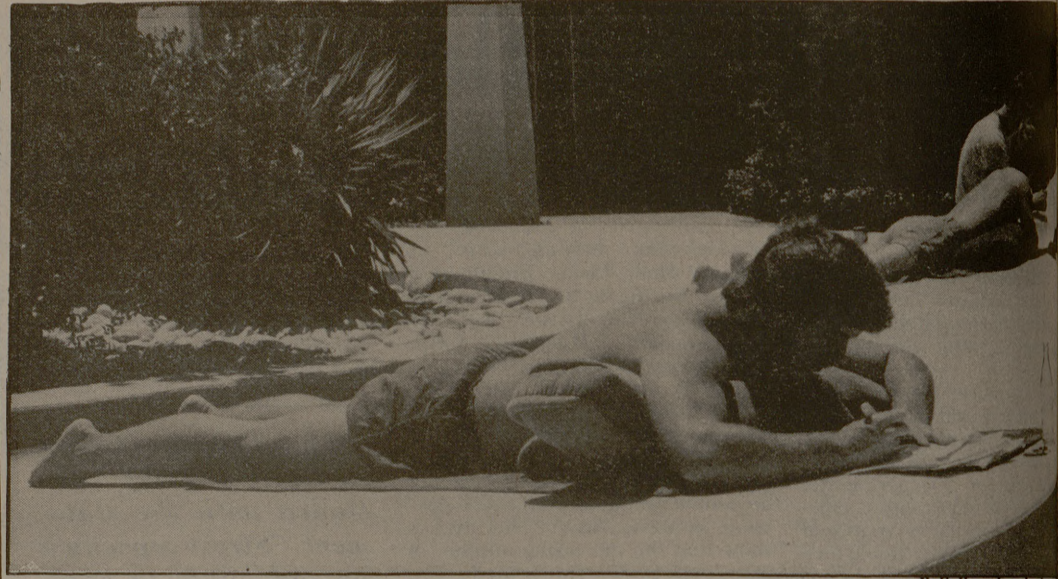
