PRAGUE, Czechoslovakia—Vietnam President Leonid Brezhnev began his first visit to Czechoslovakia in five years today and messengers reported he walked heavy steps and looked tired. Thousands of Czechs lined Prague's streets and cheered Brezhnev, 71, who arrived in Moscow to start a four-day visit which came three months after the 10th anniversary of a Soviet invasion crushed a liberal Communist movement.

The Soviet leader, wearing medals pinned to the lapel of his business suit, smiled broadly as he drove from the airport and into the streets of the capital of Czechoslovak leader Gustav Husak at his side. But witnesses said Brezhnev looked weary as he greeted his other leaders and said he was heavy as he inspected an honor guard.

GUATEMALA CITY—Hundreds of armed peasants and three privately owned farms in northern Guatemala Monday were beaten back by land in a bloody battle that left 30 men and women dead and 35 military sources said Tuesday. Army troops stationed near the scene of the battle, near the town of Panzós, about 124 miles north of Guatemala city, tried to fight the sources said. Soldiers were injured in the clashes.

Sporadic clashes were still going on Tuesday, as the government flew troop reinforcements from the capital. Soldiers searching the area for wounded. The battle began when about 400 landless peasants and women armed with machetes and a few pistols and shotguns invaded three private farms in the banks of the Polochic River sources said.

Farm workers beat them in a pitched battle ensued. Radio reports said the 38 men and women killed in fighting had been laid out in the Panzós town hall. Air force planes were dropping the injured to hospitals in Coahuila.

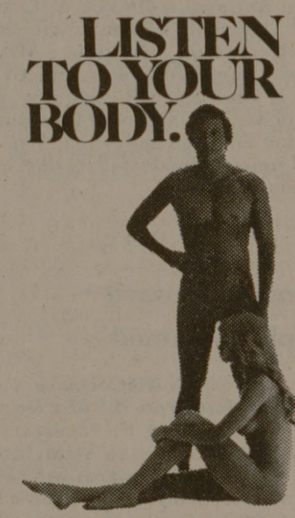
BONN, West Germany—Believe a blonde, 25-year-old woman arrested with three terrorists in Yugoslavia may be a common link to some of the most sensational assassinations including the murder of Aldo Moro and purported leader of the Baader-Meinhof gang, was by Yugoslav authorities. Rolf Clemens Wagner, 33, of the Baader-Meinhof gang, was arrested in West Germany in 1977. But there was some question when Yugoslavia would extradite the four to West Germany. Sources said Belgrade apparently wanted to swap them for exiles it believes involved in the Yugoslav diplomats and tensions in West Germany in 1977.

Justice Ministry spokesman Binder said Monday Yugoslavia arrested the four before they could be extradited. But that would not agree to any swaps.

Miss Mohnhaupt was described as the "big fish" of the four by Interior Ministry officials, who she, Wagner and Miss Heilmann were charter members of the Baader-Meinhof gang. German security police said she may be linked with the former former Italian Prime Minister Aldo Moro, who was killed by the Italian Red Brigades.

There have been numerous reports of cooperation among terrorist groups and authorities. Italian police seized a letter ring to "Brigitte" from an Italian, who tried to swallow it. It was detained in Milan last month.

Miss Mohnhaupt and Wagner also are suspected in the West German industrialist Hanns-Martin Schleyer, who was killed Oct. 18 after authorities refused to free 11 imprisoned members of the Baader-Meinhof gang. In addition, the same police high on the most-wanted list slaying of West German General Siegfried Buback in 1977 and banker Jürgen Ponto July 30.

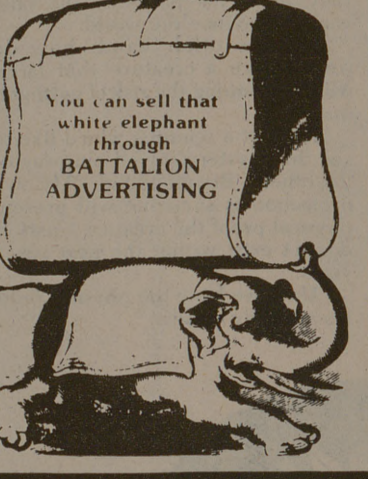
